

A layer of surface hoar was buried with this last storm. It is easy to find it and test; just shovel down 1-2 feet and cut a column. I could see the grains in my pit wall, but it did <u>not</u> break in Compression Tests or Extended Column Tests. This is good news, but it's distribution and stability is not definitively known yet.
