Remote triggered a soft <u>slab</u> with a <u>ski cut</u>. Cut across top of slope and the <u>slide</u> initiated ten yards below. <u>slide</u> was approximately 25 feet at the crown and ran the whole length/ width of the gulley. Couldn't see past the choke of the gulley . Thicker at the crown where snow was wind drifted 16 in~. Dug a quick pit after. HS 80 cm. <u>Slab</u> on top of crust and facets. No one was caught and we skinned back up and skied out our original skin <u>track</u>.
